

ASSIGNMENT OVERVIEW

- Watch the assigned PEAK Career Videos.
- Write a brief summary and reflection paragraph for **ALL** of the careers presented.
- Select and research at least **TWO** careers you are interested in. Search for local companies that hire for those careers on the Your Future website:
www.greaterbinghamton.yourfuturenewyork.com/
- Complete **ONE** of the four Exploration Activities.
- Attach all of your work on separate pages.

SUMMARY & REFLECTION

Summaries & reflections should be a minimum of **3-5 sentences** each. Consider the following questions when writing your summaries and reflections:

- What about the speaker's occupation intrigued you?
- What, if anything, did the speaker tell about his or her job that you could see yourself doing?
- What parts of the job would you not be willing or able to do?
- Had you ever heard of this company or occupation? What did you know about it before watching the video?

EXPLORATION ACTIVITY 1

Conduct an informational interview with an adult who works in a field similar to the speaker. Write 6 interview questions and a paragraph summary explaining if you think this job is a good fit for you and why.

EXPLORATION ACTIVITY 2

Create a Venn diagram to compare and contrast two of the careers you researched. Write a paragraph explaining which of the two jobs are a better fit for you and why.

EXPLORATION ACTIVITY 3

Using the Your Future website, research local companies hiring for one of your researched careers. Write a brief cover letter explaining what skills or experiences make you a good choice for the position.

EXPLORATION ACTIVITY 4

Write a "Day in the Life of a..." story for one of the careers you researched. The story should be at least 3 paragraphs and use a variety of descriptive details from the Career Video and your research.

Research Tips: Start with the companies in the Career Videos & utilize the **Your Future website**; Visit the U.S. Department of Labor site, O*NET (www.onetonline.org) and O*NET My Next Move (www.mynextmove.org) to research the speakers' careers and similar occupations.
